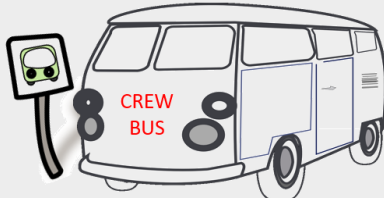
- If **Security level changes**, GeelongPort will advise you via VHF Channel 12 or 16 and / or by phone.
- Adam Gordon is the **Port Facility Security Officer (PFSO)**. Should you have any **additional security requirements** please contact the duty PFSO on +61 3 5247 0300



- The Port **requires confirmation** that your vessel complies with the ISPS Code and may require a copy of your **International Ship Security Certificate/or Interim Certificate**.
- **If requested a copy of the certificate should be given** to the Port Facility Security Office, Port Marine Controller or your agent.



- The facility has **secured gates and a security guard** controlling vehicle and pedestrian access.
- If you require any **additional security guards**, this can be organised by your agent, and will be **charged at cost**.
- We do not require a **Declaration of Security (DOS)**. If a DOS is required, we will advise your agent.



SHIPS CREW

- All **ship's crew** will be required to **have a photo ID on them at all times** as they will be checked going to and from their ship.
- **Ships crew** leaving and returning to their vessel **must use the Ports Crew Bus**, **crew are NOT to walk within the facility**.
- The **Crew Bus schedule** will be provided by the **Ships Agent** on ships arrival at the berth.
- It is possible to request the Crew Bus at **other times** by ringing 5278 6985.

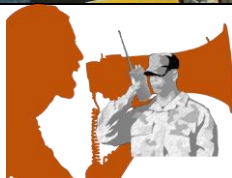


VISITORS TO YOUR VESSEL

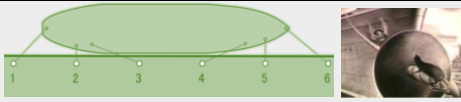
- The Port requires **written authorisation from the Ships Master/representative** prior to your visitor's arrival.
- Visitors will also require **photo ID and must be escorted** to and from the vessel.
- **Under no circumstances should a visitor walk within our facilities**. A **bus is available to transport visitors** to the ships and will be at the ship/ gatehouse on the hour or as required.



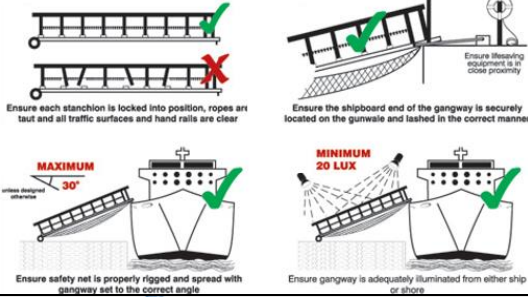
- Vessels are **not to warp ship, shift lines or engage engines without gaining prior approval** from Port of Geelong



- **Ship to shore communications is to be maintained at all times**. In case of Emergency, cease cargo operations and contact Port of Geelong



- **Mooring lines to be maintained and taut at all times.** Large vessels will pass without notice. If more lines are required contact Port of Geelong- Victorian Regional Channels Authority (VRCA). **Rat guards are to be rigged at all times.**



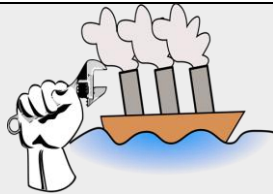
- Shore Gangways must be rigged properly in **compliance with the IMO regulations** with safety nets and sufficient illumination in the hours of darkness. A gangway watch is to be maintained at all times during the period alongside the berth



- **Cargo working and deck areas shall be clean**, clear of any debris and **well lit during the hours of darkness** for safe cargo operations
- Ship personnel, contractors and visitors shall refrain from depositing any litter or abandoning any unwanted material on the berth area



- **Smoking is prohibited** in all Geelong Port Buildings and open access. Smoking is only permitted in designated smoking zones.



- If any **maintenance or repair work** is to take place on the vessel contact Port of Geelong and ensure that **Work Permits** are issued prior to any work commencing



- Ship personnel shall abide by any direction from GeelongPort staff regarding **Health Safety and Environmental**.



- Contact Port of Geelong prior to any **bunkering operation**



- Safety apparel (**PPE**) hard hats, hi-visibility vests and safety footwear must be worn in all operational areas



- All persons **enter the GeelongPort Berth Facilities** entirely at their **own risk**. GeelongPort accepts no responsibility for any loss, injury, death, damage, destruction, cost or expense whatsoever rising to any persons, property, goods and effects whilst they are on the berth facilities
