

Mandatory use of face masks

On Thursday 30 July 2020, the Victorian Government announced, from Sunday 2 August 2020 at 11:59pm it will be mandatory all Victorians wear a face covering when outside their home, regardless of where they live.

As a result, anyone entering and working at GeelongPort from Monday 3 August, will be required to wear a face mask.

We ask that anyone entering or working at GeelongPort wears a face mask at all times when on site.

If you do not have a face mask, you will not be permitted entry into GeelongPort.

The only time you will not be required to wear a face mask at GeelongPort is in line with State Government advice including:

- if you are affected by a relevant medical condition – including problems with breathing, a serious condition of the face, a disability or a mental health condition.
- if you are travelling in a vehicle by yourself.
- when consuming food, drink or medication.
- during emergencies.

Our priority remains the same, to ensure the health and safety of our team members, contractors, port users and the wider community.

If you are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19, no matter how minor, please do not come to GeelongPort facilities, stay home and get tested.
